Mr Gorton then asked whether it would be possible to use some of the funds from Sir William Ackroyd's legacy but the Parish Council pointed out that the funds were to be used for capital projects that would have a lasting benefit to the community.  Mr Gorton also said that the Old Chapel Stores were prepared to contribute £100 per annum towards the sponsorship of a general handyman.  Mr Gorton also again raised concerns about the poor state of the lay-by opposite the village shop which he felt may at some future point be the cause of an accident.
