It was noted that the special drainage arrangements at Lydden Meadow had worked well.	
3.	Michael Covell from the Manor House, Buckland Newton showed details of plans he is applying for. It was concluded that the plan to move the cars away from the front of the house and the planting would soften the look of the house and terrace. The Parish Council will be supporting his applications.

(DCC Highways raised the bed using a considerable amount of material a few years ago as part of the Rural Roads Protocol and resurfacing of the B3143). c.
