1	County Councillor Jill Haynes gave an update.  Youth Activities - In Dorset there are 82,000 children under 18 with 32,000 of them under 13. Less than 10 percent of these youngsters attend a youth club. The budget needs to be reduced, therefore different ways of offering youth activities are being looked at. Running buildings costs money, so Youth Workers need to be out and about with Social Media also being used. A survey was done with 2500 responses.  Tricuro - This went live in July. It is already making savings. CC Jill Haynes had to give a presentation at Bournemouth, which went well, resulting in an invitation to Number 10.
