Kidney dialysis, have a chronic illness or short term medical condition, are disabled, have special communication needs, have a young baby or receive a state pension. Resilient Community Fund - Communities can apply to the fund to get money to help in the event of a significant power outage or emergency weather event, eg to enhance community facilities that would be used in the event, to protect residents, or to improve communication.
