	question of whether 'new' potential housing development plots should be included in	
	the Draft Plan as some landowners were not in a position to submit them at the time

After a lengthy debate, it was proposed and seconded that no new plots should be added as those currently listed have all been subject to lengthy assessment by WDDC and statutory planning consultees as well as public community consultation, in addition the current plots satisfy the criteria for number of homes to be built of 15 year period averaging 2 - 4 properties with approx 55% of them affordable.
