1	Dorset National Park - Sandra Brown Sandra Brown gave the Parish Council a short presentation on the Dorset National Park proposal. National Parks have a responsibility to conserve and enhance the environment, promote recreation, health and well-being and the enjoyment and understanding of the special qualities of the area, and foster the economic and social well-being of their communities. The proposal to Natural England embraces the Dorset and East Devon Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and what remains of Thomas Hardy's Egdon Heath between Dorchester and Wareham. This is just a starting point and other councils have already expressed their support and wish to be included. It is hoped that councils will consider a resolution or message, welcoming the continuing evaluation of the NP proposal and looking forward to Natural England's next assessment. A small surplus of loose chippings will remain on the surface for up to 48 hours. This will be removed by a suction sweeper.

# 2 Play Area/Parish Field

The Play Area has had its annual safety check. Overall finding: considerable resources and work have been put into the site, which has resulted in a much higher standard of provision.

- Cable Way Carpet on top of ramp need to be repaired
- Cable Way Chain covers prevent a thorough inspection of all chain links.
- Slides Monitor slides as they can become very warm in sunny conditions
- Swings crossbar attachments are loose
- Geo-textile needs to be secured in places.
