8 1	Highways Proposed temporary road closure – BT have applied to close the road at SPRING GROVE, BUCKLAND NEWTON from Duntish Garden to Thatched Cottage, a distance of approximately 400 metres. The closure has been requested to allow BT to provide new telegraph pole for new customer connection. These works are programmed to commence from 22nd August 2018 for 2 days with an end date of the 23rd August 2018 between 09:30 and 15:30. The road closure is necessary for safety reasons, as the works will take place within the whole width of the carriageway.

3	Lay-by in Duntish (Duntish Oaks) – The layby is maintained by highways, but the land surrounding the carpark is private, therefore it is down to the landowner to trim.	
4	SID - The SID is not entirely straightforward as there are quite a few restrictions from Highways, as well as ongoing/up keep costs. The Parish Council concluded that it is an expense that cannot be funded by the Parish Council at this time, but the Parish Council would support any parishioner/s who wanted to pursue other avenues of funding.	
5	Parish Clerk to write to Mr Sherry, politely asking whether he could cut his hedge back (just above the shop on the right hand side) as it has become overgrown, forcing traffic to drive in the middle of the road.	SM
